PRESENTATION

Chorey-les-Beaune is an AOC of 330.3 acres located in Côte d'Or, mostly producing Pinot Noir.

This Domain has been passed on from one generation to the next, and is today run by Lorraine.

Her approach is very much inspired from the previous generations' respect in keeping the Corton spirit alive: deep robe, red fruit aromas, finesse and powerful.

Elaborating fine wine relies primarily on the quality of the raw material.

It is for this reason that we insist on taking great care during all phases of the vine's natural cycle and remain respectful to both plant and its environment. It is therefore no surprise that we have opted for a sustainable-organic approach that best suits our convictions: the non-use of herbicides and insecticides, sustainable grass-covering and ploughing techniques throughout the Estate...

WINE TASTING

Deep ruby color. Delicates flavors of dark fruits, berries and cloves. Nice freshness on the finish with silky tannins. It can be drunk when young, but can also age 5 to 8 years in the cellar

WINE AND FOOD PAIRING

Meat in gravy and mature cheeses

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

GRAPE VARIETY : 100% Pinot Noir

AVERAGE PRODUCTION: 3 000 bottle/year

SURFACE : 0Ha50

AGING : 18 months in oak barrels, 25% new barrels

SOIL: Clay and limestone

WINE-MAKING : Cold maceration system, temperature control
