Garrigue

AOC Languedoc, rosé



Varietals

- ◆ Cinsault : 40%
- ◆ Grenache: 30%
- ◆ Syrah: 30%

Appellation

Located north of the Languedoc Aoc, in the Pic St Loup area, Chateau Lascaux is a 90 acres estate nestled along the foothills of the Cevennes Mountains. The estate is certified organic since 2009 and the vines are planted on limestone soils known locally as "Lascaux".

Grapes selection

Ten years old vines planted on a twelve acres limestone parcel surrounded by oak trees.

Vinification et Élevage

Harvested half by hand and half mechanically, the crop is directly pressed to avoid coloring after being cooled off. Totally de-stemmed, the grapes are fermented at low temperature for a few weeks before aging in tank, on its lees, and finally bottled in January.

Producer

Jean-Benoît Cavalier took direction of the property in 1984, just after finishing a degree in Agricultural Engineering. In 1990, he consolidated the vineyards, restructured the ancient cellars, and created the official domaine, Château de Lascaux.

Annual Production of this wine: 2,000 cases

Tasting notes:

Color: Salmon pale colored.

Aromas: Strawberries and raspberries red fruits mixed with mineral tones.

Palate: red fruits with orange notes, gourmand with a touch of mineral notes in the back palate.
